1. ABOUT TRAVEL TALK

Thank you for purchasing **Travel Talk**, the hands-free speakerphone for your wireless handset, from ORA Electronics, a leader in cellular accessories and enhancement products.

Travel Talk is the hands-free speakerphone system for wireless handsets that can travel with you – from vehicle to vehicle. This unique, portable system is actually two products in one, a hands-free speakerphone and a power cord.

Featuring an integrated, high quality microphone and high-powered speaker for clear, sharp conversations, **Travel Talk** enables hands-free use of a wireless handset in a vehicle. In addition, **Travel Talk** functions as a power cord, allowing you to simultaneously operate your handset and charge your battery.

Compact and portable, **Travel Talk** requires no installation. And, it's easy to use. Just plug **Travel Talk** into your vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle and your handset, and you're ready for the convenience of hands-free conversation.

Small enough to fit into a briefcase or purse, **Travel Talk** also includes a convenient mounting cradle to provide easy access to your handset.

4 SETTING-UP TRAVEL TALK

To Position the Cradle

1. To position the cradle, attach (with the included double-sided tape) the cradle to a safe, convenient location in the vehicle.
2. Remove your wireless handset from its carrying case and place your handset in the handset cradle. Do not remove the battery from the handset.

To Plug Travel Talk into your Handset

1. Turn your handset OFF.
2. Plug the speaker end of **Travel Talk** into your vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle.
3. Plug the microphone end of **Travel Talk** into the appropriate receptacle on the handset. It will "snap" or "click" into place.

NOTE: Do not force the connector into place. The connector will slide easily into place when inserted properly. Failure to do so may damage Travel Talk or your handset.

4. Turn your handset ON. Your handset is now operating on your vehicle's power.

NOTE: When your cigarette lighter receptacle has power, your handset may turn ON automatically.

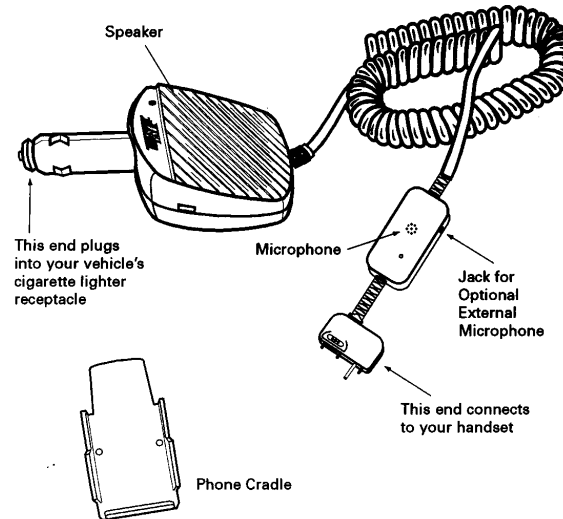
To Position the Travel Talk Speaker

1. To position the **Travel Talk** speaker, press and hold the button while you adjust the speaker position.

2. PACKAGE CHECKLIST

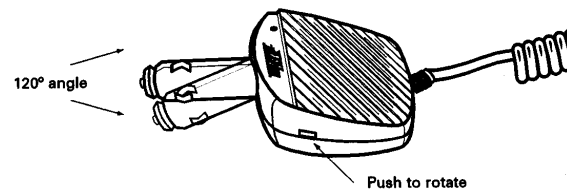
This **Travel Talk** package contains the following components:

- 1 - Travel Talk unit (with attached speaker and microphone)
- 1 - Handset cradle
- 1 - User's Guide



SETTING-UP TRAVEL TALK (cont.)

NOTE: The Travel Talk speaker will rotate 360° in a vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle. Pressing the button on the Travel Talk speaker allows you to move the speaker up and down 120° for optimum positioning.



2. The optimum position for the **Travel Talk** speaker is pointing away from both the handset and the **Travel Talk** microphone and into the cavity of the car (a good direction is into the passenger side leg area). This allows the sound to "swell," creating greater clarity, and preventing signal interference from the handset.
3. When you have found the optimum position for the speaker in the vehicle, release the button. The speaker will lock in position.

To Position the Travel Talk Microphone

1. The optimum position for the **Travel Talk** microphone, is facing you, pointed away from the **Travel Talk** speaker, and no further away than your arm's reach.

3. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

NOTE: Please Read the Following Information Carefully Before Using Travel Talk.

- For your protection, the **Travel Talk** cigarette lighter adaptor contains a glass tube fuse. When necessary, replace the fuse only with the same type of fuse. Use of other fuses may damage your telephone and/or your vehicle's electrical system and may cause overheating to the point of flash.
- The **Travel Talk** speaker may become warm during use. This is normal. It is not normal, however, for the speaker to become HOT (too hot to touch) during use. If this occurs, remove immediately and discontinue use of **Travel Talk**.
- ORA Electronics does not recommend the use of your handset while operating a motor vehicle.
- Always keep the coiled cord away from areas which may impair your driving.
- Do not expose **Travel Talk** to rain or extreme moisture, or extreme hot or cold temperatures.

5. OPERATING TRAVEL TALK

Once the **Travel Talk** unit has been properly set-up, your handset is ready for hands-free use.

Using Travel Talk in Hands-Free Mode

1. **Travel Talk** will automatically select the "hands-free" mode on the handset.
2. To ensure that you are speaking into the microphone, talk towards the **Travel Talk** microphone. If you have installed **Travel Talk** correctly the microphone will be facing you and you can see the LED light, making this your "talk zone".
3. The volume for **Travel Talk** is controlled by your wireless handset. If you want to increase or decrease the speaker volume, adjust the volume by using the volume control buttons on your handset.
4. If you wish, you can switch the handset back to normal hand-held use and disable the hands-free mode. Simply remove the connector from the bottom of the handset and use in the regular hand-held manner. To return to hands-free mode, simply plug the handset connector back into the bottom of the handset.

OPERATING TRAVEL TALK (cont.)

NOTE: When in hand-held mode, the handset is operating on its own battery power.

To End a Call with Travel Talk

1. End your call as you would normally.

NOTE: If you keep Travel Talk plugged into your vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle, Travel Talk will continue to operate as a power cord, charging your wireless handset's battery. When leaving your vehicle for any extended period of time, it is recommended that you unplug Travel Talk from your vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle, to prevent drain on the vehicle's battery.

To Remove Travel Talk from Your Handset

1. Remove the speaker end of Travel Talk from your vehicle's cigarette lighter receptacle, and the connector from your handset.
2. To remove the handset from the cradle, simply slide the handset in an upward direction until it slips out of the cradle.

6. TRAVEL TALK SPECIAL FEATURES

Travel Talk Power On/Off Indicators

The **Travel Talk** LED lights will remain on after your phone call has ended and you have hung-up. The purpose is to indicate that the **Travel Talk** unit is using your vehicle's power to charge your handset's battery; they do not indicate that the **Travel Talk** unit is in use.

Travel Talk Function as a Power Cord

Travel Talk also operates as a power cord, allowing you to power your handset using your car's battery power. This provides you with unlimited in-vehicle talk and standby time and saves your handset's battery power for true portable use. In addition, **Travel Talk** is also capable of charging your wireless handset's battery, when the handset is turned on, whether you are using your handset or not. For additional capabilities, please refer to your handset's Instruction Manual.

7. OPTIONAL EXTERNAL MICROPHONES

For noisy conditions in a vehicle, an external microphone can be added.

All Electronics has two electret microphones that work with Travel Talk, CAT# MIKE-62 and MIKE-70. Any electret microphone with a 2.5mm phone plug will work.

8. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. Where should the speaker be positioned?

- A. To obtain the greatest clarity and crispness, you should position the **Travel Talk** speaker so that it points into the cavity of the car, away from both the **Travel Talk** microphone and your wireless handset. (A good direction to try is into the passenger side leg area compartment.) This allows the sound to "swell" and prevents signal interference from the handset. Experiment with the speaker position until you've found the optimum position.

Q. What should I do to prevent speaker and microphone feedback "howls"?

- A. To prevent feedback howls, you should position the **Travel Talk** microphone so that it faces away from the **Travel Talk** speaker.

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS (cont.)

Q. How do I charge and operate the handset at the same time?

- A. You don't need to do anything special to operate your handset and charge your battery at the same time, just plug **Travel Talk** in! **Travel Talk** functions as a power cord even if you are not using your handset in a hands-free mode.

Q. How do I operate the volume control?

- A. **Travel Talk** does not have volume control. If you want to adjust (both increase and decrease) the volume of your telephone conversations, you must use the volume control buttons on your wireless handsets.
